PRIVACY STATEMENT

This privacy statement (the "Privacy Statement") discloses the privacy practices of iThentic ("We," "Us," "Our" or the "Site Owner") with regard to the websites for the series Guidestones found at <u>www.guidestones.org</u> (the "Site").

Information Collection & Use

Registration

In order to access and use certain portions of the Site, you must first complete the registration form. Customer Service

Based upon the personally identifiable information you provide Us, We will send you a welcoming email to verify your account. We will also communicate with you in response to your inquiries, to provide the services you request, and to manage your account.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

Personally identifiable information:

We rarely share personally identifiable information, and only for the following purposes, with third parties:

Agents

We may use a third party service provider to conduct surveys, contests or voting; that company is prohibited from using Our users' personally identifiable information for any other purpose.

<u>Legal</u>

We reserve the right to disclose your personally identifiable information as required by law and when We believe that disclosure is necessary to protect Our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on the Site.

Log Files

As is true of most web sites, We gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data.

We use this information, which does not identify individual users, to analyze trends, to administer the Site, to track users' movements around the Site and to gather demographic information about Our user base as a whole.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We use cookies on the Site and you may opt to have a cookie store your user name and password so that you do not have to enter it more than once in certain areas of the Site.

Links to Other Sites

This Privacy Statement applies only to information collected by the Site and other websites related to Guidestones controlled by the Site Owner.
